Coorer design. The greens are a push-up style bent/poa mix and the tees and fairways are a bent/rye mix, surrounded by a bluegrass rough. The golf course and clubhouse grounds are meticulously cared for, making the property truly extraordinary. The Denver Country Club exudes tradition and history and, club members take great pride and enjoyment in the facilities.
