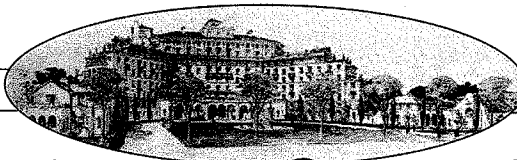

Westchester Country Club is seeking three (3) turf student interns for the 2009 season.

Westchester Country Club is a forty-five (45) hole complex. The West Course (The Championship Course) is the site of the "The Barclays", a PGA Tour event that will be held again in August 2010 as part of the PGA Tour's Fed Ex Cup. Through the beginning of August the top one hundred forty-four (144) players will be determined by the new point system. These one hundred forty-four (144) top players will qualify for the Fed Ex Cup. Westchester Country Club will be the first event in this schedule which will last four consecutive weeks and the winner will walk away with ten million dollars. The South Course, although considerably shorter than the West at 6,539 yards, offers the golfer a challenge with very small greens and rolling hillsides. The nine (9) hole executive course with eight (8) par 3's and one (1) par 4 gives the golfer an opportunity to practice his/her short game. We have a thirteen (13) acre driving range with a teeing area of (2.5) acres.

We have a staff of fifty-five (55) employees, which includes five (5) assistant superintendents, three (3) equipment technicians, one (1) office manager and forty-six (46) laborers. The staff responsibilities include all maintenance of the golf courses, fifteen (15) fast-dri tennis courts, five (5) grass tennis courts, over six (6) miles of roadways and all grounds including the areas around our three hundred twenty (320) room hotel. The hotel houses transients as well as year round residents. A separate facility on Long Island Sound is our Beach Club, which also falls under our grounds maintenance responsibilities.

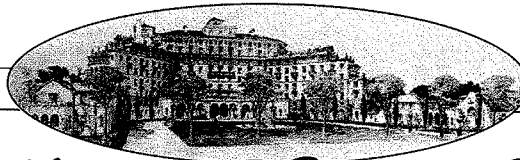
