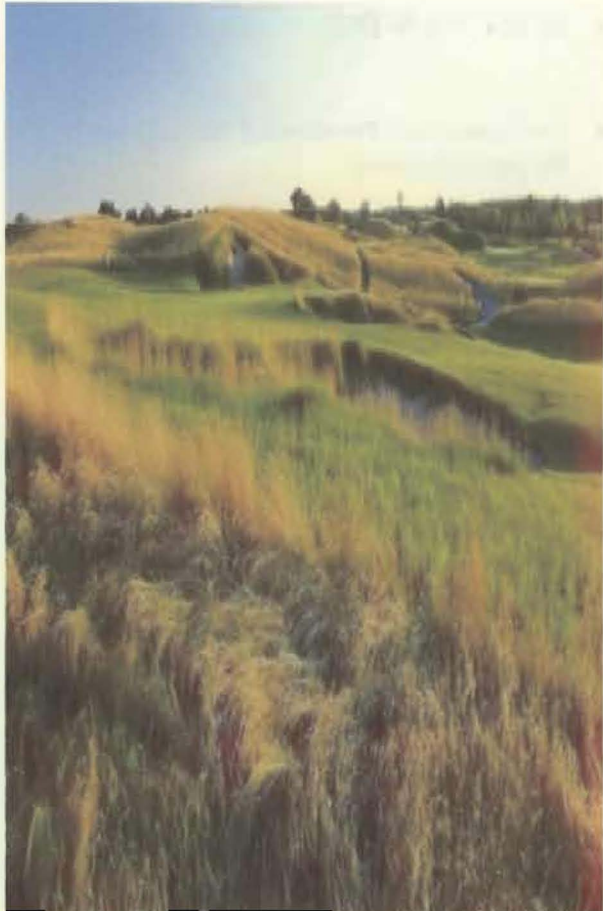


Erin Hills rest on 652 acres of

Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

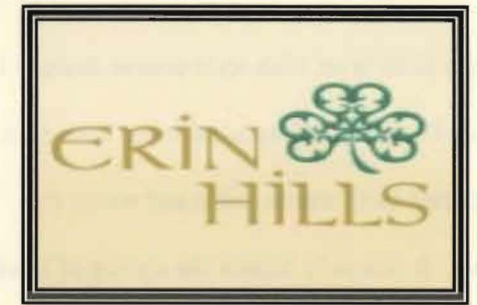

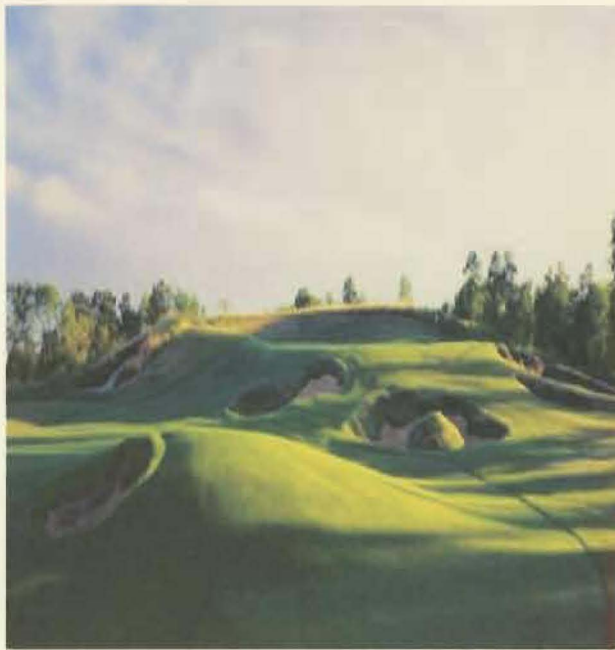

Since the start of construction in 2004, Erin Hills has bonded with the USGA and has already played host to the 2008 Women's Amateur Pub Links. This summer Erin Hills will host the 2011 U.S. Amateur, and will also be the site of the 2017 U.S Open. Erin Hills is single-minded in its emphasis on golfing, pure and simple. Everything that we do is focused on presenting championship golf for the everyday golfer.
