

## Research Scientist I

The Sevilleta Long Term Ecological Research (LTER) Program at the University of New Mexico is seeking to fill a position at the level of Research Scientist I beginning August 24, 2009. This position is primarily a field ecology position and requires the ability to live at the field station Monday through Thursday for 26 weeks of the year; then working on campus in Albuquerque the remainder of the year. The primary responsibility of this position is to collect and manage data for ten long term research projects. Most of the research projects focus on plant ecology with some small mammal and insect work.

Under direct supervision, uses fundamental concepts, practices, and procedures of particular field of specialization to perform routine scientific research tasks requiring application of established techniques, procedures and criteria.

This is a full-time benefits eligible position and the University of New Mexico (UNM) provides a diversified package of benefits including medical, dental, vision, and life insurance. In addition UNM offers educational benefits through the tuition remission and dependant education programs.

Minimum Qualifications: Bachelor's degree; at least 6 month of experience that is directly related to the duties and responsibilities specified.

Preferred Qualifications: Preference will be given to candidates that possess a Master's degree.
